REGISTER OF PEOPLE WITH SIGNIFICANT CONTROL

The Companies Act 2006 provides that companies, including charitable companies, must keep a register of people who have significant control (PSC) over the company. The aim of the PSC rules is to oblige UK companies to significantly increase the level of transparency about who exercises significant control over them.

As all multi-academy trusts (MATs) are established as charitable companies limited by guarantee, they are caught by the PSC rules. Accordingly, every MAT must complete a PSC register, even if there are no relevant people to include. A company's PSC register can never be blank.

Every MAT must also deliver the information in the PSC register annually to Companies House as part of its 'Confirmation Statement'.
